Camporee Logistics

Theme

With the Winter Olympics in PyeongChang occurring in February, the theme of this camporee is the Winter Olympics. All unit patrol competitions will be themed along a Winter Olympic sport or activity. There is also the ability to use South Korean culture in these competitions. The cost will be \$10 per person with a free adult credited for every 10 scouts from a unit.

PLEASE NOTE: FOOD WILL NOT BE PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT.

There will be a First Aid Station in the Dining Hall. There will be youth and adult restrooms in the dining hall. They will be clearly marked for adult and youth use. Water will be available outside the Dining Hall. Only one vehicle will be allowed in the campsite Friday night, temporarily. Vehicles must be parked in the parking lot at the front of camp. tents need to have "No Flame in Tent" signs. Each tent must have a Fire Bucket filled with either sand or water. Each unit is responsible for their own food and cooking equipment.

Patch Trading

Patch trading among all present will be available in the dining hall on Saturday after the patrol competitions. This is an opportunity to find an OA patch you have been looking for or grab that old North Star patch from years ago.

Patrol Competitions

All units must bring the same number of competitions as patrols. If this poses a problem for your unit, please contact Thomas Jacoby. Patrol competitions should last 20 - 30 minutes each.

Polaris Award

Specialized patch rounders will be awarded to each member of the patrols that finish in the Top 3 overall in the Patrol competitions. Oreos will be awarded to the top 5 patrols. The overall #1 winning patrol will have their picture taken and will receive recognition on the North Star District's Polaris Award.

Willie Award

Judging for the North Star District's Willie "Best Campsite" Award will start at 2:00 Saturday and will continue until all campsites are judged. The scoring matrix will be released by January 10th to Troop Scoutmasters via email. All Scouts, except for the Senior Patrol Leader, should be outside of camp during the judging. A troop may ask for their scorecard after the camporee is complete. Decorations will not be judged as a part of the Willie Award and no special awards will be presented for best campsite decorations.

Camporee Red Hats

Red Hats are presented to adult leaders for their continued participation, support, and attendance at North Star District Camporees. An adult leader is eligible to receive their Red Hat after attending seven or more District Camporees. Each Troop should provide a list of eligible adults during check-in on Friday night.
